Terms of Reference for posts of Fisheries Development Officer

1. Background:

The Government of Orissa in partnership with Government of India has initiated a project to achieve the goals of sustainable utilization of coastal areas without causing any notable degradation of its habitats and deterioration of the ecosystem and avoid the adverse impact of unplanned and incompatible development. As one of the components of the national initiative through integrated coastal zone management (ICZM) approach like in states of Gujarat and West Bengal, the approach is being piloted in Orissa. This component will include capacity building of the state level agencies and institutions, including preparation of an ICZM plan for the coastal sediment cells that include the stretches of Paradip to Dhamara and Goplapur to Chilika, including regional coastal process study, and pilot investments. It has adopted Integrated Coastal Zone Management activities.

Under Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project, State Project Management Unit (SPMU) has been formed under the Department of Forest and Environment, Government of Orissa and will implement the Orissa component of this national initiative. The project envisages execution through primary and secondary institutions from the State Project Management Unit to the community level groups.

2. Objectives of the Project:

The overarching objectives of the project is to provide for the best long –term and sustainable use of coastal natural resources and for perpetual maintenance of the most beneficial natural environment through full involvement of all the stakeholders through a comprehensive and integrated programme. In order to do so, the underlying objectives of the project include:

- Building up of the National capacity for implementation of comprehensive coastal management approach in the country, and piloting the integrated coastal zone management approach within state of Odisha.
- To build state level capacity to manage coastal zone issues is a necessary complement to the national level capacity building, given the constitutional division of responsibilities between the state and national governments.
- The key outcome indicators will be:
 - i) The existence of an appropriate national institutional structure for guiding and coordinating implementation of ICZM approaches,
 - ii) The number of “knowledge benchmarks” showing improvement according to end-users of knowledge services,
 - iii) The number of completed pilot ICZM activities demonstrating cross-sectoral and spatial integration; and

iv) The number of other ICZM plans initiated to replicate the lessons learnt.

The initiatives proposed under ICZM Project, Orissa has following objectives;

- Formulation of Integrated Coastal Zone Management Plan for the State
- Coastal Erosion and Associated Oceanographic process
- Vulnerability to Disaster
- Biodiversity Conservation
- Livelihood security
- Pollution/ Environmental quality management

- Improvement and conservation of cultural / Archeological assets

3. Organization and Implementation Structure:

The overall responsibility for the project implementation and coordination for the component designed for the state rest with the State Project Management Unit, Integrated Coastal Management Project, Odisha which has been established to serve as a coordinating agency. The State Steering Committee (SSC) is the apex body chaired by the Chief Secretary, Government of Odisha while the Principal Secretary, Forest and Environment, Government of Orissa is the Vice –Chairman. This Committee includes representatives of various implementing departments and civil society. The Project Director of SPMU, ICZMP, Odisha will act as Convener of SSC.

PEA for Component of Fisheries: Fisheries & ARD department, Government of Odisha is responsible for the proper implementation of the different developmental schemes in inland, Brackish water and marine sector. The Directorate of Fisheries, Odisha is mandated for implementation of the fisheries component under ICZMP, Odisha.

4. Job Description:

- Required to work in the field as per requirement of the assignment and suitability from time to time. He /She shall ensure coordination between PEA and different stake holders for effective implementation of the fisheries component under ICZM Programme of the State of Orissa.
- Will technically assist the Nodal Officer in the implementation and financial management of the project sub-component.
- Shall play a leading role in coordinating the functions of SHG and their overall management under this project.
- The job of the person will be to provide technical support and assist the SHGs and ensure that financial management is carried out as per the Financial Management / Financial Rule for the Society and World Bank norms in implementation of different components/ sub components of alternative livelihoods options for fisher folk.
- Shall be responsible for preparing all reports and returns pertaining to implementation of the fisheries programme in the field as and when required.
- Shall be delivering on any other related works assigned to him by the Nodal Officer/ Assistant Director of Fisheries(M) as may be required from time to time.
- Shall liaise with the field project implementation.
- Shall coordinate & support workshops, meetings and seminars, etc.
- Shall monitor the activities of the implementing SHGs and their performance and required to inspect the works frequently.
- Any other work assigned to him by the Nodal Officer/ Project Implementing Officer (Assistant Director of Fisheries (M) from time to time.

5. Essential Qualification: He/ She should possess a Degree in Bachelor of Fishery Science (B.F.Sc) / or Higher from recognized University/ Institute with excellent academic record.

6. Essential Work Experience and other Attributes:

- a) At least 2 years of post qualification experience at the state or community level activities in related field.
- b) Experience of working with similar programmes is preferable.
- c) He/ She should have fluency in English, Oriya and Hindi, excellent in drafting and verbal communication skills.

- d)** He/ She should be physically and mentally fit to discharge the duties prescribed and capable of undertaking extensive tours.
- e)** He / She will be liable to serve any where in the area of the project operation.
- f)** Knowledge of computer application will be added advantage
